Projects

Energy Efficiency & Energy Transition Department

As in previous years, the focus of the Energy Efficiency & Energy Transition Department in 2019 was on energy-saving projects in schools and daycare centres. In almost all cases, the successful cooperation of the previous years was continued. In addition, new energy-saving projects were initiated in Lübben/Luckau, the Havelland district and the town of Birkenwerder. The BEACON project—a flagship project of the European Climate Initiative—was continued and expanded and deepened in exchange with European partners. Within the framework of the BEACON project, teachers from various European countries were trained and development workshops and climate action days were held. The success of and response to the project have contributed to the staff of the department becoming known as education experts beyond Germany. This also applies to two other projects funded by EUKI (European Climate Initiative): “Climate Schools Berlin Athens” and “TICA Bulgaria”, both of which were successfully continued in 2019. In 2019, the department was thus once again able to contribute to structurally establish energy efficiency projects in schools not only in Germany but also in our European partner countries. Together, we have again taken an important step towards our goal of creating a permanent European network of energy-saving schools.

In 2019, the Energy Efficiency & Energy Transition Department also produced its first expert reports on nature and environmental education. In addition to the Berlin district of Reinickendorf, we were also able to produce an expert report for the home district of the UfU—Berlin Pankow.

Projects

Climate Protection & Transformative Education Department

With its projects, the Climate Protection & Transformative Education Department demonstrates ways and possibilities of how education in very different areas can help to bring about a change in awareness and rethinking on an individual level. A central concern of the department is to develop methodological approaches and to implement them in practice. Transformative learning is understood in this case—following the example of educational researcher Mandy Singer-Brodowski—as a process based on a change in individual perspectives of meaning. In the field of climate protection and transformative education, these methodological approaches are put into practice in the project Klimamacher, the participatory exhibition on energy system transformation entitled “Turning Energy Together,” and in the for the Global Ideas Reportage Project of Deutsche Welle, to name only a few examples. In addition to these pilot projects on transformative education, the department in Berlin cooperates with the Museum of Natural History of Berlin since 2019. Together with the Museum of Natural History, the department has designed and implemented a participatory exhibition on deep-sea research. Under the title “Research Through Time. On Expedition into the Deep Sea”, the exhibition offers school pupils the opportunity to engage interactively with historical, current and future marine research. Particularly noteworthy is the joint project KlimaGesichter (“Climate Faces”), which was launched in January 2019. The project aims to qualify refugees and immigrants as climate ambassadors. The aim of the project is to initiate concrete climate protection measures through intercultural exchange. At the same time, the project aims to draw attention to the close connection between climate change and the causes of flight.

Nature Protection & Environmental Communication

From 2016 to 2019, UfU, together with the landscape conservation association “Grüne Umwelt”, the Julius-Kühn-Institut Braunschweig and Umwelt- und Geodaten-Management GbR, carried out the project “ENVISAGE—Registration and Management of Invasive Neophytes on Agricultural Land to Secure Agricultural Production Conditions”. This project was successfully completed by the Department of Nature Protection Environmental Communication in 2019 with a workshop at the State Agency for Agriculture and Horticulture of Saxony-Anhalt. The results of the project were published on a website specifically designed for this project and can be viewed at www.neophyten-in-der-landwirtschaft.de.

On behalf of the Ministry of Environment, Agriculture and Energy of Saxony-Anhalt (MULE), the department was again able to offer and conduct training courses and excursions for people involved in water maintenance in 2019.

A project started in May 2019 investigates how invasive alien species affect environmental protection measures, especially species protection measures, and how the two aspects of environmental protection can be better combined. Project funding was secured through December 2021. Within the framework of the project, the measures for the control of giant hogweed and yellow skunk cabbage carried out by the department between 2010 and 2018 were evaluated for the first time.

Environmental Law & Participation Department

In 2019, the department was once again able to strike a good balance between projects with a research focus and projects with a practical orientation. With a total of thirteen different contract and funding agencies, the department succeeded in further diversifying its funding sources last year.

The completed evaluation of the Federal Environmental Information Act represents a major success for the department. The department also participated in a feasibility study on an environmental data cloud forming part of the Federal Environment Ministry's (BMU) environmental digital agenda.

In the field of research on public participation, 2019 saw the launch of the monitoring report on public participation in environmentally relevant infrastructure projects. For the first time in Germany, the report lists all procedures in which citizens and environmental associations actively participated in infrastructure projects.

About half of all projects in the field have an impact abroad. Particularly noteworthy is the close cooperation with our partners from Vietnam. Of the total of eleven foreign projects, eight were implemented in Vietnam. The focus lay on the continuation of projects to record and treat soil contamination in post-mining landscapes and projects on climate adaptation and air pollution control. In addition, we had projects with partners in Georgia, India, Colombia, Moldova, South Africa, Turkey and Ukraine. Within the COBENEFITS project, new co-creative methods and forms of political dialogue were tested in South Africa, Vietnam, Turkey and India to create policy recommendations for a favourable political environment for renewable energies. A special highlight for the staff of the department was the "ClimateOpportunity 2019" conference on October 15th and 16th at the Futurium in Berlin.
